COIMBATORE COURT SENTENCES FIRM & ITS PARTNERS FOR MISUSE OF ISI MARK

The Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) operates the Certification Marks Scheme under the provisions of the BIS Act, 1986 for the use of Standard Mark (ISI Mark) on various products. 90 products like LPG Cylinders, LPG valves, LPG regulators, tyres various milk products, electric cables, Packaged Drinking Water, steel, cement, etc. are under the mandatory certification scheme.

With the increase in the popularity of the ISI Mark, instances of misuse have also been observed. On receipt of information regarding misuse of ISI Mark by any firm, BIS undertakes raids on such firms and if misuse of ISI Mark is established then cases are filed in Court. As per Bureau of Indian Standards Act 1986 such offenses are punishable by imprisonment up to one year or a fine upto Rs. 50,000/- or both.

Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS), Coimbatore Branch conducted a search and seizure operation on 22 August 2012 at the premises of M/s Sri Jayaram Industries, 10/2980, Trichy road, Ramanathapuram, Coimbatore – 641 045 and seized spuriously ISI Marked Packaged Drinking Water under brand name "Amoga" and "ALKARICH". BIS case was filed against the above firm for violation of BIS Act 1986, Section 11 (1) & 14, Subsection 33 in the Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Coimbatore.

The accused were found guilty by the court of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Coimbatore, and the Firm's partner & Manager were imposed a fine of Rs. 45000/-, to each, and if they failed to remit fine, simple imprisonment of one week each. Total amount of fine was Rs. 3,60,000/-.

It has been observed many times that fake ISI marked products are manufactured and sold to common consumers for huge profit. Therefore, people should ascertain the genuineness of ISI Mark on the product before purchase by visiting BIS website <u>http://www.bis.org.in</u>.
