

BIS goes the 'Greener Way'

Giving a boost to its Green Initiative, Bureau of Indian Standards has augmented the capacity of the Rooftop Solar Power Plant at BIS Headquarters, New Delhi. There has been an enhancement of 52 kW over the existing 48 kW capacity, bringing the total installed capacity to 100 kW.

The 100 kW plant is regularly generating over 500 units of energy on sunny days, contributing to substantial reduction in the carbon footprint of BIS. The plan is to extend the initiative to other locations of BIS Offices where suitable rooftop spaces are available.

The project has been completed through M/s Fourth Partner Energy Pvt. Ltd., who are empanelled by Solar Energy Corporation of India (SECI).
