Illegal water bottling plant faces action

Coimbatore: A water bottling plant in Erode was found functioning without a valid license from the Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS). However, they continued to use the ISI mark on all their water pouches, bottles and jars which were seized from the factory premises and action against the company is being initiated.

On Monday, the Coimbatore branch of the BIS formed a team to conduct search and seizure operations on packaged drinking water in Bhavani in Erode district. During the raids, they seized many 250 ml pouches, 1 litre bottles and 20litre jars from a Bhavani-based company called Nethraa Industry, said a BIS press statement issued on Thursday. "They had fake ISI marks on packaged drinking water pouches under the brand name Silo Fresh, one litre PET bottles under the brand name Dew Drops and 20 litre water jars under the name Swasm and Agha said the statement. Under the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India Act 2006, a BIS license to use the ISI mark on packaged drinking water products is a must TNN
