\* BIS RAIDS ON MANUFACTURERS OF Packaged Drinking Water UNIT

A team of officials from Bureau of Indian Standards, Pune Branch Office conducted a raid on 10/05/2017 at M/s S S Jadhav Foods Pvt Ltd., Survey No. 6/2A, Tathawade, Pune 411 033 a manufacturer of packaged drinking water with spurious BIS Standard Mark, ie. I Mark, without having valid Licence. Such Products are used by common consumers. A very Large quantity of 20 litre PET Jars, duly filled in and labels used on PET Jars with BIS Standard Mark, ie. D Mark with brand name: "Marvelous " & "Blue Dues" without holding BIS licence, with spurious 🖾 Mark were seized during the raid.

Action is being initiated against the offender under the BIS Act, 1986. The offence is punishable by imprisonment up to one year or a fine upto Rs.50,000=00 or both.

The general public is requested to be aware of the offense that the manufacturing units do not have a valid BIS licence shall not use Bureau of Indian Standards Certification Mark and give information about any misuse of ISI Mark which comes to their notice.
