BIS SEIZES PVC INSULATED CABLES WITH ISI MARK

In Delhi Branch Office-II, Bureau of Indian Standards, a discrete information was received that PVC Insulated Cables with ISI Mark without valid licence was being manufactured at a factory situated at 32/1 Dilshad Garden Industrial Area, Shahdara, Delhi.

A team consisting of three officers from DLBO-II with the help of Police personal from Seema Puri Police Station were sent for a raid at the premises 32/1 Dilshad Garden Industrial Area, Shahdara, Delhi on 03.08.2017. All the material marked with ISI Mark under different brands, namely, **SERVOCAB CABLES**, **STANCAB CABLES & VISCON CABLES** brand as per IS 694 were found at the premises where PVC Insulated Cables with ISI mark was being manufactured without a valid licence, which is a violation of BIS Act 1986. About 60 (approx.) nos. of coils and 5000 (approx.) packing material with ISI mark was seized at the premises.

This offence is punishable under section 33 of BIS Act 1986 which includes fine upto Rs 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty thousand) or imprisonment upto one year or both and forfeitures of any property in respect of which contravention had taken place. Legal action, including launching of prosecution against the offender is being initiated by BIS.

BIS, from time to time, cautions the general public, in their own interests, and advises to be careful while purchasing ISI marked material, since large quantity of spuriously ISI marked material have been pushed into the markets by unscrupulous elements. In case, any misuse of ISI mark is detected and reported to BIS, prompt and timely action is taken by the Bureau for carrying out search & seizure operation(s) and launching prosecution against the offenders under BIS Act, 1986.
