Quotations(s) in duplicate in a sealed cover by Registered Post superscribed **“Quotations(s) for Scrap” should reach the undersigned latest** by 1500h on **23 March 2007**. Any quotation after this date and time will be entertained. The quotations shall be opened on the same day in the presence of tenderers or their authorized agents/representatives.

2. The above material can be inspected before submission of the quotation on any working day between 1000h and 1600h by contacting the undersigned/Section Officer (Lab).
3. Each tenderer has to deposit a sum of Rs.”2000” by Demand Draft in favour of the Bureau of Indian Standards payable at Chennai as Earnest Money Deposit along with their quotation. **Quotations received without EMD shall be summarily rejected.**
4. The Tenderer(s) whose quotations(s) is/are accepted shall be required to deposit within a week of intimation a sum of Rs.5,000/- as Caution Money for performance/obligation arising out of the contract. In this case, the tenderers may adjust the amount of Rs.2000/- paid as EMD and deposit Rs.3000/- by DD for making the total deposit of Rs.5000/-. Failure to deposit this Caution Money of Rs.3000/- by the due date may lead to cancellation of the offer and forfeiture of the tenderer’s Earnest Money.

The EMD of Rs 2000/- received from the unsuccessful tenderers shall be returned.

5. All materials necessary for weighing (Platform Weighing Balance)/packing etc. have to be brought by the parties. In case of doubt, the Bureau reserves the right to have the weight rechecked by its own sources and the decision of the Bureau shall be final and binding on the party.

6. The labour for removal of scrap, weighing, loading/unloading etc., shall be provided by the party.
7. The material will be lifted from the place of storing at the cost of the parties.
8. 50% of the approximate cost of the scrap shall be deposited before weighing and the balance shall be deposited before lifting the related material.
9. The material will have to be taken delivery of at a time on any working day (Monday to Friday) between 1000h to 1600h except Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays.
- 10. If the material is not lifted within 10 days of intimation of the offer, the same shall stand rescinded and no claim whatsoever will be entertained and scrap will be disposed off to the next highest bidder.**
11. The Bureau reserves the right to dispose to reduce/cancel/add fresh items on all quotation(s) submitted in whole or in part without assigning any reasons whatsoever.
12. Sales Tax applicable in the State shall be collected from the party. Please note that this Institution is not exempted from payment of Sales Tax. We cannot provide "C" or "D" form and therefore tax, if any, may be included in the quotation.
