- 1. All taxes /Service Charges/ VAT to levied, shall be clearly mentioned in the quotation in absence it will be treated as inclusive of all charges. And PAN / TIN no. shall be clearly mentioned.
- 2. Tender will not be considered if is not accompanied by the requisite amount of Earnest Money Deposit (EMD).
- 3. An Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of **Rs. 5000/-** in the form of DD/ Banker's cheques or bank Guarantee valid for atleast Six months from a Nationalized Bank drawn in favour of BUREAU OF INDIAN STANDARDS payable at New Delhi / Ghaziabad. The EMD will be returned to unsuccessful bidders there after and for successful bidder it will be returned or adjusted in performance guarantee(PG) 10 % of the Bill amount which will be retained for a period of one year and returned there after. No interest will be paid for EMD or PG.
- 4. All jobs executed shall be subject to approval on inspection. The decision of our inspecting officer shall be binding and final.
- 5. Rates for extra, altered, additional or substituted, etc., items or work shall be got approved before carrying out the same.
- 6. The contractor shall complete the work within **45 days** form the date of commencement of contract.
- 7. The time allowed for completing individual jobs shall be intimated from time to time and BIS shall reserve the right to cancel/rescind/revoke the order, if job is not carried out in time and is not confirming to the approved specification.

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8. No claim on account of fluctuation in rates for labour on handling, carriage, taxes, royalties, etc., will be entertained.

- 9. It shall be the contractor's responsibility to provide experienced skilled labours for the jobs. In the event of the contractor's inability to do so, the Bureau shall reserve the right to terminate the contract without any notice.
