Expression of Interest for Undertaking Factory Assessment / Surveillance audits under Product Certification Scheme of Bureau of Indian Standards

Bureau of Indian Standards is an autonomous body functioning under the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, Govt of India. Its primary functions, as given in the Bureau of Indian Standards, Act 1986 are standardization, quality certification of products and services.

BIS (Western Regional Office) invites Expression of Interest (EOI) from organizations possessing the technical expertise and infrastructure to carry out joint preliminary factory assessment audits and independent surveillance audits of BIS licensees under its product certification scheme, according to BIS Terms and Conditions and at the charges mentioned therein. The interested organizations should be of repute having proven expertise in their respective field of operation(s) and with experience in certification related activities.

BIS (Western Regional Office) operates Product Certification Scheme in the states of Maharashtra, Daman and Silvassa, Goa and Gujarat for products like:

1. Chemical and Allied products, Pesticides, Food Products, Irrigation Equipments, Cement and Cement Products etc;
2. Lot Inspection of LPG, Cylinders and Valves & Regulators, High Pressure Cylinders & Valves , LPG Stoves etc;
3. Steel and Steel products, Wood products, Plastic Pipe & allied, Fire extinguishers, Sanitary appliances etc;
4. Electrical Items : Household Electrical Appliances, Wiring accessories, Pumps and Motors etc;

The last date for submission of EOI is 16 May 2008.
