Dear Sirs,

Bureau of Indian Standards, Mumbai intends to dispose-off scrap/ remnants of tested samples and obsolete material as per Annexure-I on the terms and conditions mentioned below. You are requested to submit the rates for all items as given in Annexure-I individually for each item. Quotation for part of the lot would not be accepted. Quotation for metal scrap should be on a unit rate basis (per kg). Copy of the Annexure-I can be used for submitting the quotation. However, the same should be signed with stamp. Quotation not meeting the terms and conditions would be rejected.

Quotation shall be submitted in a sealed envelope superscribed **“QUOTATION FOR LIFTING OF REMNANTS OF TESTED SAMPLES AND SCRAP”** and the same should be submitted to the Bureau latest by 1500 hours on 19 July 2010. The quotation shall be opened at 1600 hours on the same day (i.e. on 19 July 2010). A tender box has been kept on the ground floor marked **“TENDER FOR DISPOSAL OF SCRAP” for dropping the quotations.** Tenderer or his authorized representative may remain present at the time of opening the quotation, if he desires so.

The contract for disposal shall be valid for six months from the date of award.

The quotation shall be accompanied with Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs. 2000.00 (Rs. Two thousand only) by **Demand Draft in favour of Bureau of Indian Standards, Mumbai. EMD paid through cheque or cash shall not be accepted.** In the event of non-acceptance of the quotation the EMD shall be refunded. The quotation not accompanied with EMD shall be rejected. No interest shall be payable on Earnest Money Deposit.

The EMD of the the successful tenderer shall be retained by the Bureau as security and would be refunded after expiry of the period of validity of quotation. For unsuccessful bidders, EMD shall be refunded immediately after finalization of the tender.

The items offered in the Annexure-I may be inspected at the premises of Bureau at Manakalaya, E-9, MIDC, Andheri (East) Mumbai-400 093, anytime between 1400 h to 1600 h on any working day between Monday to Friday with prior intimation to the Section Officer.

The successful bidder shall have to take delivery of material within **15 days** on any working day during office hours against full payment in advance, failing which, the Earnest Money Deposited shall be forfeited. All quotations shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 60 days from the date of opening of quotations.

In the process of removing the items from our store, the bidder will be responsible for loss of any property of the Bureau due to negligence on his part or on the part of his representatives and the amount of loss shall be recovered from the tenderer.

The tenderer will have to remove the entire lot of scrap on **“As is Where is Basis”**.

Bureau of Indian Standards reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason.

The Bureau shall have no responsibility for delay, loss or non-receipt of quotation after despatch.

In case of any dispute, the decision of Bureau shall be final in the matter.
