World Standards Day is a celebrated internationally each year on 14 October. The day honours the efforts of the lakhs of experts who develop voluntary standards within standards development organizations such as the International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC), International Organization for Standardization (ISO), International Telecommunication Union (ITU), and BIS. The aim of celebrating World Standards Day is to raise awareness among regulators, industry and consumer s regarding the importance of standardization in the global economy. 14 October was specifically chosen to mark the date, in 1946, when delegates from 25 countries first gathered in London and decided to create an international organization focused on facilitating standardization. Around the globe, various activities are chosen by national standards bodies and intergovernmental organizations to commemorate the date. Bureau of Indian Standards being the National Standards Body and the founding member of ISO also celebrates this day with great enthusiasm every year. On the occasion of the World Standards Day 2022, many events were organized by BIS, JPBO 1 in Jaipur.
