RPBO conducted a day-long sensitization program for the following MoU institutes:


- National Institute of Technology (NIT), Raipur

The other activities included discussion with the questioner about BIS, educational outreach programs of BIS, and digital initiatives of BIS. The discussion and group activities on a standard-specific approach to identify the R&D work were carried out with the faculty and scholars.









LERNING SCIENCE VIA STANDARDS

Raipur Branch Office conducted a two-day training program on "Learning Science via Standards" at Raipur district. The program was attended by 103 participants from 70 schools in 16 districts. The program was inaugurated in the presence of Shri Dibyendu Chakrabarti, DDGE, and dignitaries from the State Council of Educational Research and Training (SCERT), Government Engineering College, Indira Gandhi Krishi Vishwavidyalya, and CIPET, Raipur. The program comprised of 1.5 days of classroom training and workshops, including discussions on activities of BIS, digital portals of BIS, and workshops on lesson plans. This was followed by a half-day exposure visit to CIPET, Raipur. RPBO has conducted all phases of training on learning security via standards.
